BELKE BRINGS TWO PLAYS TO THE 2012 FRINGE

For his twenty-third year as a Fringe playwright, local favorite David Belke is presenting two plays at *The Village of the Fringe*. One is a much loved play that David premiered back in 1999 (and long overdue for a return), while the other is David's twenty-third consecutive premiere at the Edmonton Fringe Theatre Festival.

The lower hall of Holy Trinity Anglican Church (Venue 32), David's home venue for the past six years, sees a brand new production of *The Minor Keys*. An all-star cast of Edmonton artists have been assembled to bring to life this rich and heartwarming comedy of intersecting lives colliding through the course of one night in a half forgotten jazz club. A complex cast of characters pursue their dreams in a full length comedy of romance and comedy set to a jazzy beat.

Launching the new Arts Space venue at Holy Trinity Church (Venue 34) is the world premiere of *Von Mitterbrink's Secon*d, a comedy/drama of scheming and dueling. Featuring a stellar company of Edmonton artists and the fight choreography of master swordsman Jean-Pierre Fournier, the play follows one young nobleman's single-minded pursuit of honour, a quest that leaps off the tracks in dramatic and comedic fashion with the arrival of his opponent's unexpected second.
