THE PROCLAMATION OF THE WORD

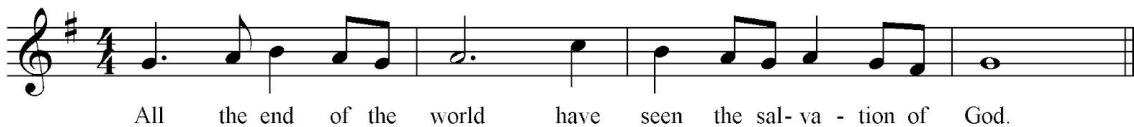
A reading from Acts 10:44-48

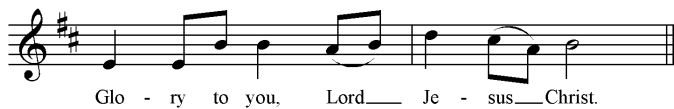

The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to **John 15:9-17**





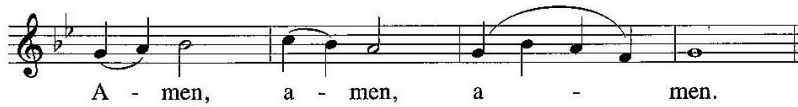
